CIRCULAR

Subject:- Implementation of Centralized Personnel Information System (CPIS) in the J&K State. Access, Verification and updatation of the data by the DDO's.

Attention of all the Treasury Officers and Drawing and Disbursing Officers of the State is invited towards circular instructions issued from time to time regarding CPIS. All the Drawing and Disbursing Officers of the State were advised and required to coordinate in furnishing of the data of employees in the prescribed formats and its digitization, verification and updatation with the nominated vendors /agencies. It has been reported that a number of DDos' have not furnished the complete information in respect of CPIS as yet with the result the project is lingering due to the negligence of employees and their DDO's. The authorities have taken serious note with a warning of stern action against the defaulters if the information is not furnished by the end of November, 2016.

To go ahead in the matter the Finance Department, J&K in coordination with Information Technology Department, J&K decided to publish the data on the web as made available by the DDO's so far with a view that concerned DDO's will access, verify and update their data and the data of remaining DDO's will be published subsequently as soon as they furnish the same. NIC has been advised to take proper action in publishing of data and creation of User id and its access to the concerned DDO's (List of Treasuries and number of DDO's along with instruction sheet enclosed for reference).

The NIC,J&K State Unit vide their No.NIC/JK/Move/2016-17/378-400 dated 04.10.2016 has intimated that they have published the CPIS data of the 100438 employees of 2069 DDO's comprising of 16 Districts on the internet, and the url of the site is http://jkcpis.nic.in. The DDO's can access CPIS portal from anywhere using any network connectivity, like broad band/data card. In case DDO don't have any network connectivity available, they can visit nearby CSC, Khidmat Centre or NIC District Centre for data updation. The NIC has prepared Treasury wise, DDO userid and password list for all those DDO's whose data has been published on JKCPIS portal for verification and updation and list will be emailed to concerned Treasury Officers email box.

The Treasury Officers are advised to collect list of User id and password of the concerned DDO's and handover same to them and the concerned DDO after collection of userid and password from TO will access the data for verification, updation and keeping of upto-date data of the employees. Those DDO's who are yet to furnish complete CPIS data for similar action are advised to submit the same immediately otherwise their salary bills from the month of November, 2016 onwards may not be entertained by the Treasury Officers in any case till the completion of the job by them.

CPIS Data updation instructions for DDO's

Data has been published on <u>Http://jkcpis.nic.in</u>. DDO can view, modify and transfer employees to other department. All those employees who have been transferred and still displaying in DDO list, DDO has to transferred to transfer to other department or in common pool if not known.

Steps to View employee:

- 1. Go to http://jkcpis.nic.in and click *login* link.
- 2. Provide login details and submit it.

 (If DDO don't have userid/password contact concerned Treasury Officer)
- 3. After successful login you will be redirected to DDO home page.
- 4. Now click view employee link then you will see all employee pertaining to the DDO.
- 5. There may be some employee appears in the list which are not belong to the DDO.
- 6. The employees which are not belonging to the DDO can be transferred to other department if known place of posting or can be moved to common pool if not known their place of posting.

Steps to transfer employee to other department or common pool:

- 1. Click transfer link on the left side of the screen.
- 2. Then employee list appears on the screen.
- 3. Choose employee to whom you want to transfer.
- 4. When you click transfer link then you will be redirected to other page.
- 5. Now fill all details related to transfer.
- 6. When you *submit* this page transfer will be done.
